

ENERGY POLICY

ArianeGroup operates in an environment impacted by **climate change, energy dependence**, and fluctuations in energy prices.

In order to minimize the company's environmental footprint, an **eco-responsible** policy has been put in place, in line with ArianeGroup's Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) ambitions.

This policy acts on five major pillars:

- > **Implementation of the Energy Performance System** – an integral part of the Health, Safety and Environment system – based on:
 - knowledge of our consumption,
 - setting energy target objectives,
 - identification of factors with significant energy performance impact,
 - development of responsible behavior on the part of staff and sub-contractors applying a cost-conscious approach to resource management,
 - continuous improvement through performance indicators, associated action plans, and audits,
 - full compliance with regulatory requirements.
- > Incorporating energy efficiency aspects into **site and production evolution plans**.
- > Integration of energy performance as a decision-making element in the **design and construction** of site infrastructures, production and testing installations, and IT resources.
- > **Management of facilities** to ensure the lowest possible energy consumption required for production and site operation.
- > **Responsible purchasing of electrical energy**, partly green energy from renewable sources.

In this context, ArianeGroup has undertaken to provide all economically reasonable resources to achieve the following objectives by the **end of 2020** (reference year 2017):

- **reduction of our energy consumption under equivalent conditions: -10%**
- **deployment of renewable energy: double the energy produced**
- **reduction in our greenhouse gas emissions: -15%**
